Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement Waiver:

I, _____ for myself, my heirs, personal representative or assigns, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue, Cougar Swim Schools, The San Lorenzo Valley Unified School District, all officers, directors, shareholders, employees, agents, representatives, successors, assigns, and heirs (collectively, "related parties"), from liability from any and all claims including the negligence of related parties, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in activities, classes, observation, and use of facilities, premises or equipment.

Assumption of Risks: Physical activity, by its very nature carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken by the Cougar Swim School Staff to avoid injuries while using the San Lorenzo Valley High School property, facilities, and equipment. San Lorenzo Valley High School property and Cougar Swim School have facilities for and provides for activities such as, but not limited to, hiking, running, swimming, spring board diving and water polo. I acknowledge that swimming, aquatic sports and other sports related activities are dangerous activities that may result in serious spinal injury or death even with careful supervision. I agree to release, indemnify, hold harmless Kurt Edwards of Cougar Swim School their employees, agents, volunteers, & waive all claims, liability, (including attorney's fee) for property damage, bodily injury, & death arising from my/child's negligence or willful misconduct relating to me or my child's participation in the swimming programs.

Some games, sports/activities, environments may lead to illness, physical injuries, psychological stress or damage. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from; 1) Minor injuries but not limited to such as scratches, bruises, strains, sprains, contact with poisonous plants, heat exhaustion, dehydration and embarrassment 2) Major injuries such as but limited to eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.
